*Deergrass ( <i>Muhlenbergia rigens</i> ) [Phase 2]		
*Toad rush ( <i>Juncus bufonius</i> ) [Phase 2, vernal pool near swimming pool]		
*Lanceleaf liveforever ( <i>Dudleya lanceolata</i> ) (native succulent) [Phase 2]		
*Italian rye-grass ( <i>Lolium multiflorum</i> ) (zipper-like) [path near bridge, non-native]		
*Poison hemlock ( <i>Conium maculatum</i> ) [non-native]

<p>*Wild radish (<i>Raphanus sativa</i>) [non-native]</p>		
<p>Wild radish (<i>Raphanus sativa</i>) [non-native, white or purple]</p>

<p>*Pickleweed (<i>Salicornia pacifica</i>) (formerly <i>Salicornia virginica</i>)</p>
